An amount of (¢50,000.000.00) fifty million cedis is sourced for training in textiles and reed crafts which is in high demand in the country and for export. After training the amount that goes into material would serve as a revolving fund to sustain the project.

IMPROVEMENT ON TRADITIONAL HOUSING

Traditional buildings have some qualities that make them very suitable, only that they need modifications like allowing windows to serve for good ventilation to keep away (C. S. M) Meningitis and other diseases that do well in heat. The use of good local material for building would be encouraged. The people would be discouraged from using expensive roofing material. Improved designs and local materials would be encouraged. Living quarters for man and animals shall be separated to avoid the transmission of animal diseases to man.

An amount of three hundred million cedis (300,000,000.00) is needed for rebuilding and renovating the houses of the one hundred farm families.

A Social centre which shall have a meeting hall, store rooms for village farm inputs and other materials and a part will serve as a clinic.

All will be built in the traditional way by the village masons, who are layman. As income generating and an ecological way of building.
